SAFETY

- > Electrical cables and equipment partially or completely surrounded with bulk insulation may overheat and fail. This applies to wiring installed prior to 1989.
- > Insulation should be installed either beneath electrical wiring, or with appropriate air gaps to prevent overheating. Consultation with an electrical contractor or inspecting authority should be made in cases where the bulk insulation would surround the cables for lengths greater than 150mm.
- > At least 100mm should be cut around all flues, vents, exhaust fans and down lights unless alternate formal advice from a qualified electrical contractor or inspecting authority has been provided.
- > Material datasheets are available on request from the manufacturer, installer or distributor.

HANDLING

- > 'Blue Sky' is 100% polyester and safe to handle without the need for masks or gloves as it is non-irritant and non toxic, however industry work safety practices should be followed at all times.

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

- > 'Blue Sky' can be easily cut with a sharp blade. Always cut slightly oversize, to ensure that the product fits firmly between ceiling or floor joists or wall framing, ensuring no gaps.
- > It is recommended that 'Blue Sky' thermal Insulation be installed by qualified/professional installers.
- > The performance of this product may be reduced if stored for too long in its compression packaging. This product typically recovers to its nominal stabilised thickness within a month after installation.
- > The total R value depends on installation and may be greater than or less than the R value of the product.

PACKAGING

- > Is made from LDPE and is recyclable, please dispose of accordingly.
