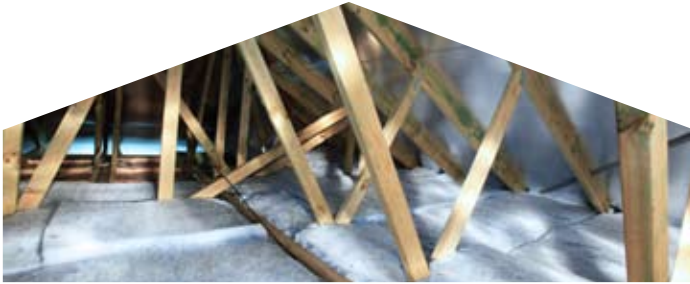

Put Polyester in the ceiling The 'R' word.

Most people aren't aware that there are different types of insulation material. Broadly, you can choose from fibreglass, wool, polyester, polystyrene boards, loose fill (from shredded material), cellulose fibre (from recycled paper) and material backed by foil.

Blue Sky insulation is made from 100% polyester fibres. They won't irritate, are completely safe to handle, non toxic, odourless, have no respiratable fibres and comply with all Australian Standards and the Building Code of Australia

Blue Sky polyester insulation won't rot, is not susceptible to mould or mildew and is naturally insect and vermin resistant and polyester is also naturally self-extinguishing when exposed to flames (whilst combustible at high temps, polyesters tend to shrink away from flames and self-extinguish upon ignition).

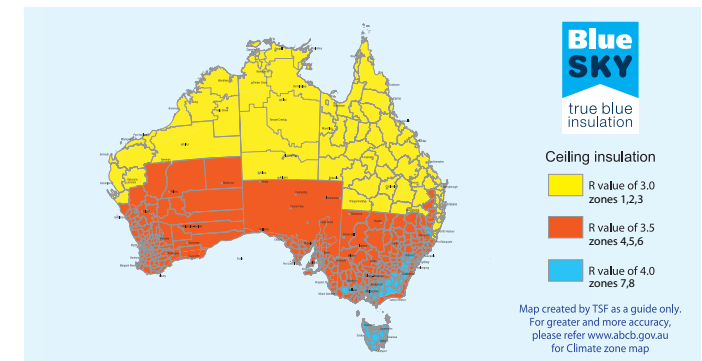
Blue Sky polyester insulation is immediately effective once installed because our manufacturing process creates a product with excellent thickness recovery. You will notice as soon as you open up a bag how quickly it 'springs back' to nearly its nominal stabilised thickness (and Declared Material R Value).



Ceiling insulation is designed to prevent heat being wasted through the roof in winter and prevent heat flowing in through the roof in summer.

To determine the right insulation for your home, you simply need to know what climate zone you live in, this will then determine what the right 'R value' (a measure of how much the particular material inhibits the transfer of heat) is for your home. The higher the R value, the more effective the level of insulation.

Your local council or your installer can advise what R value insulation material is right for your home. We've included a map showing the different R value zones of Australia.



Buying Blue Sky insulation.

Blue Sky insulation will be available from August 1, 2009 and will begin with an R3.0 and R3.5 in both 430 and 580mm batt widths. All Blue Sky insulation batts undergo rigorous quality assurance testing to ensure compliance with:

- AS/NZS4859.1
- AS1530.3
- Building Code of Australia
